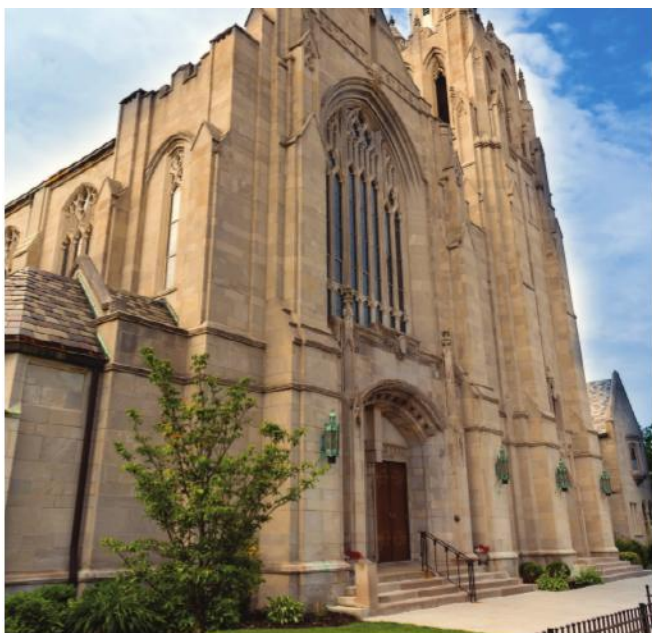

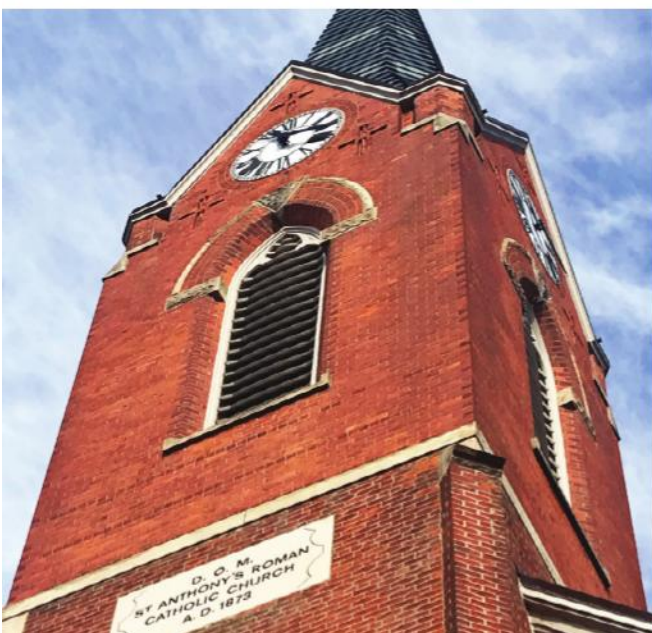

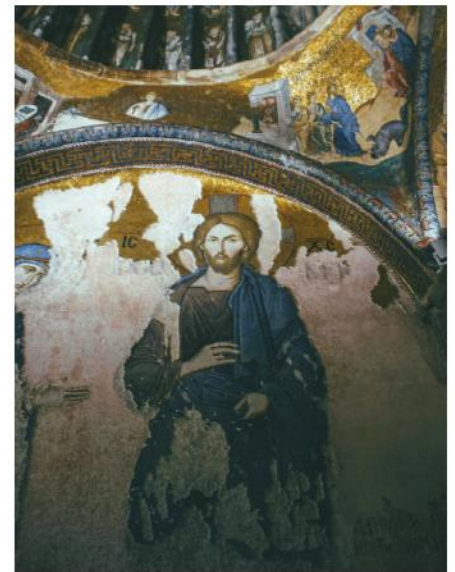

Never Forget: September 11, 2001

Let us never forget
those who were lost and
those who loved their
brothers and sisters
so much they made the
ultimate sacrifice.

On Wednesday, we will remember the profound loss we experienced on 9/11. Let us spend the day in memory of those we lost and for all of the firemen, police officers, and first responders that risked their lives that day and every day. This year we will have a Mass at 9:00 a.m. at St. Cecilia for those who serve our community. Please invite them for a special blessing. We will also have the church open so that all can come before Our Lord in Adoration and pray for the first responders. Please share this information with your local first responders and public servants. Let them know we will be holding them in our hearts and minds while visiting the Most Blessed Sacrament.

If you haven't been to Adoration before, I want you to take time to visit this Wednesday, even if it's only 15 minutes, half an hour, or an hour, to come in and pray. When you enter it is customary to do a double-knee genuflection. Let the time you spend with God draw you closer to the holiest of desires — peace and love. You can bring prayer books, read scripture or sit in silence. There are no rules except to give time to Our Lord in prayer and contemplation.

Amen? Amen.

September 11 Prayer of Remembrance

O Lord, you who are the God of the living and the dead, we remember this day those who died on 9/11: we thank you for all who sacrificed their lives in the service of others, we pray that you would heal any lingering traumatic memories and that you would mend all relations that remain broken still, between neighbor or nation, and that you would kindle in us the true love of justice and peace, so that we might work toward a day in which nation shall not lift up sword against nation. We pray this in the name of the Prince of Peace. Amen.
