Pastor's *Corner*

Catholic Schools Week

Catholic Schools Week is a time to appreciate the work that so many individuals do to provide a wholesome education to young boys and girls. This education differs from other modes because it focuses on more than mere knowledge; Catholic schools offer truth. Other schools teach math, but they do not teach how God has ordered the world in a way that is both good and beautiful. Other schools teach language arts, but they do not teach how to use language to uplift others and promote life. Catholic schools also offer perhaps the most important lessons that are absent from non-Catholic schools: lessons in the faith. The Catholic Church was created by God and is the only source of His entire truth. When our society is not rooted in this truth, we lose sight of what is true. So many young people grow up without this wisdom and understanding, and so we find that they are lost and cannot find any truth in which to root themselves. Pope St. John Paul II once said that the greatest challenge and greatest contribution that Catholic education can make "is to restore to that culture the conviction that human beings can grasp the truth of things, and in grasping that truth can know their duties to God, to themselves, and their neighbors." Now more than ever, we all need to embrace this challenge and provide our children with this opportunity to discover the truth.

Amen? Amen.




Jubilee Year 2025



In the sixty years since this ecumenical council has concluded, Vatican II has become one of the most debated and divisive topics in modern Catholic conversation. Some say Vatican II was a blight on the reputation of the Church, undermining tradition, eliminating hierarchy, and going too far in reforming the liturgy. Others will argue it ushered in an age where the laity could take on a greater role in serving the Church and clarified our relationship with other traditions. The most severe critics have even gone so far as to reject Vatican II's legitimacy, giving rise to the sedevacantist movement and bringing many Catholics out of communion with Rome.



Come for the whole day, just for the chili cookoff, or just for the Super Bowl. Either way, we can't wait to see you all there.


