Seek the face of the Lord

These words from Psalm 105 were chosen as the episcopal motto of Archbishop Dennis Schnurr upon his consecration as Bishop of Duluth in 2001. For the last 17 years, he has been leading those of us in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati to also seek the face of the Lord. And now, after 51 years working to build God's kingdom as a priest, Pope Francis has accepted his retirement.

Growing up in a small Iowa town with a population of about 700 across less than a half of a square mile, young Dennis probably never saw himself becoming responsible for the souls of over 3 million people across 8,543 square miles of southwest Ohio. But he sought the face of the Lord, and this is where he led.

Vocations has been Archbishop Schnurr's priority, as evidenced by the *Vocations Prayer* we all say before Mass. As Bishop of Duluth, the number of seminarians increased from 8 to 24 men over just seven years. In Cincinnati, we have seen 60 men ordained since 2014, which would have

roughly been the first class of seminarians to enter under Archbishop Schnurr. I've had a chance to meet a lot of seminarians from all over the country, and there are very few people that have seen these kinds of numbers on a regular basis.

As a seminarian, the archbishop has been like a father in many ways. Multiple times every year he invites us to his house, and he comes to the seminary nearly once a month for various events. In 2020, my first year as a seminarian, he came and addressed us amid the COVID epidemic. I remember his calm demeanor as he gave us words of encouragement, calling us to be strong.

Archbishop Schnurr, thank you for shepherding of this Archdiocese, and know of our prayers for you during this time of transition. And to Archbishop Casey, thank you for your response to the call of being our new shepherd. Know that we will be praying for you as well, that you too may always seek the face of the Lord.

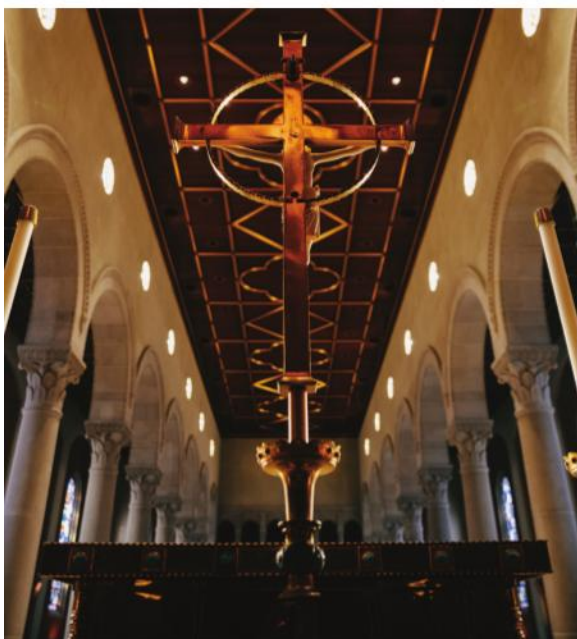
