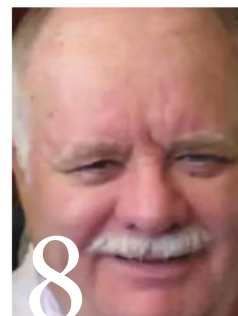

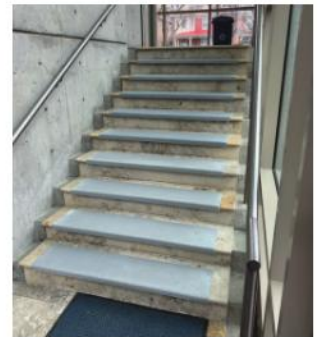

St. Mary Church Steps Update

A couple of projects are underway at SMHP. The granite block steps in front of church need to be completely re-done due to separation and water penetration. All doors will be accessible during weekend Masses — half of the front steps will be worked on at a time. Please note: the front doors may be closed during weekday Masses. The front steps will be completed before Easter.

There is also work being done to the stair treads inside the elevator entrance. There are temporary fiberglass treads in place while new travertine pieces are sourced and re-installed. We appreciate your patience while we make these improvements.

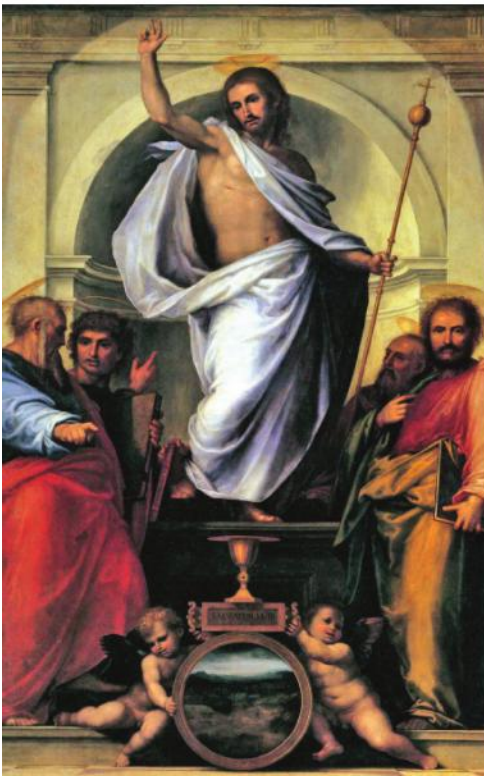
